We provide myopia control and orthokeratology for children and adults. We prescribe for myopic, hyperopic and multifocal ortho-k. You will also gain experience with specialty lenses i.e. keratoconus, scleral lenses, etc.

The **practice management** portion of the practice will give you insights and experience in running a successful practice.
